Official Rules Agreement

1. By entering this contest, hereinafter referred to as the "Contest," I, as evidenced by my signature below, hereby agree to all the terms and conditions set forth below.
2. Contest will take place April 18th and 19th, 2008 at Mall of America, 60 East Broadway, Bloomington, MN 55425.
3. Employees of "Contest of Kings" and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter this contest. All contestants must be at least 16 years of age and must show proper identification.
4. Contestants who are banned voluntarily or involuntarily from Mall of America or Contest of Kings – Mall of America Contests are ineligible to participate. Should a contestant be banned during the Contest, the contestant will no longer be eligible to participate in the Contest and will forfeit any entry fees provided.
5. All contestants must submit their application along with a photograph in costume and a Bio/Informational Essay about your show (500 characters maximum including spaces) no later than March 1st, 2008. These items will become the property of Contest of Kings – Mall of America and will not be returned. Contest of Kings – Mall of America official contest entry mailing address is Momentum Productions, 7933 Edgewood Ave N, Brooklyn Park, MN 55445.
6. Competition schedule will be determined during our sound check at 5pm on Friday, April 18th at the Rotunda in the Mall of America. All contestants will draw a number from a hat, that number will be your place in Round One. The competition schedule will be reversed for Round Two.
7. Any contestant that misses their performance time may be removed from any further scheduled times on later rounds.
8. A panel of three (3) "Contest of The Kings" contest officials will score the contestants during Round One and Round Two and select the highest scoring contestants who will advance to Round Three.
9. Round Three Contestants will redraw numbers for their performance order. Round Three will be judged by our seating area audience.
9. Scores will be based on the number of points earned per judging ballot. Two "Contest of Kings" officials will tally the ballot votes.
10. Judging Criteria is scored for a possible 100 points per song and is broken down by 25 points each for 4 categories as follows:
 - Vocals** (includes tone, range, getting the lyrics right, and performing in the accurate and authentic Elvis style);
 - Appearance** (includes "The Look," song/era/costume quality, appearance and era continuity, hair, jewelry, footwear, make-up, attention to detail, etc.);
 - Movements** (includes song performance specificity/continuity and effective, natural performance of quintessential Elvis stage movements, mannerisms, gesticulations);
 - Stage Presence** (includes interaction with the audience, charisma, seeming "at home" on-stage, originality as long as it's consistent with respectful Elvis depiction, over-all "fun factor" and positive audience reaction).Basically, how do you compare to "The King?"
11. All contestants are to perform as single acts. No groups or bands are allowed. Contestants must supply their own musical materials. All background tracks must be in standard CD format.
12. Each contestant will sing three (2-3) songs of their choice for each round, the top finalists will each sing three (3) songs as they compete in Round Three and one (1) additional song upon accepting their prize.
13. No devices or props other than guitars, Teddy bears and scarves are allowed. Any scarves or other personal material handed to a member of the audience becomes the property of that audience member.
14. Contestants will be provided a dressing area at the Mall of America where they can change costumes. This is in a secured area, but "Contest of Kings" will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
15. "Contest of Kings" will reserve one seat for each contestant and one companion who is accompanying a contestant. Additional seats are available at the ticket table or on our official website.

16. Each contestant's performance shall be in accordance with acceptable community standards. "Contest of Kings" may, at its discretion, remove any contestant that it believes is performing in bad taste. No profanity or vulgarity is allowed and will result in the immediate disqualification of the contestant. At the discretion of the contest judges and officials, contestants will be immediately disqualified for engaging in activities that give the contestant an unfair advantage, such as pledging support to a charity to solicit votes, trash talking, heckling, etc.

17. All decisions and rulings by the "Contest of Kings" officials, Momentum Productions employees or their agents will be final.

18. "Contest of Kings" reserves the right to change these rules or cancel this Contest at anytime without liability. In the unlikelihood that this event is cancelled, all entry fees will be returned to contestants.

19. Contestants agree that they are performing voluntarily and will not receive any compensation and are only eligible to win prizes offered by "Contest of Kings." At the discretion of "Contest of Kings," prizes to be awarded may be adjusted to compensate for lack of contestant entry fees.
